

## Bruntsfield Mondays

- Dance for 2 couples in a 4 couple longwise set 8x32 bar Jig
- 1-8 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> couples dance right hands across and left hands back.
- 9-16 1<sup>st</sup> couple lead down the middle and back (2s step up on bars 11 and 12).  
At the end 1<sup>st</sup> man crosses 1<sup>st</sup> woman in front of him to finish in a line of 4 across the dance, 1<sup>st</sup> woman facing 2<sup>nd</sup> man and 1<sup>st</sup> man facing 2<sup>nd</sup> woman.
- 17-24 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> couples dance a reel of four across the dance. At the end of the reel, 1<sup>st</sup> couple pass giving right hands instead of the final left-shoulder pass.
- 25-28 1<sup>st</sup> couple lead up (right hands joined), cross and cast off into 2<sup>nd</sup> place.
- 29-32 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> couples turn by the right hand.

Repeat, having passed a couple.

This dance was written for the Edinburgh Council Beginners class, which meets in Bruntsfield Primary School on Monday evenings. I needed a simple dance to teach reels of four, and numbers were low so it couldn't be a 4-couple dance. This was the result.
